Job Overview

The YFC Community Coordinator will serve as the face of YFC to area schools, churches, and the community at large with the ultimate goal of pointing people to Jesus Christ. A successful coordinator will possess the spiritual gifts of service, administration, leadership, and exhortation as each will be needed to carry out the mission of YFC. A small part of this job will be fundraising to keep the ministry going, but the main focus will be sharing the love of Jesus Christ through the ministries of YFC.

Responsibilities and Duties*

- Coordinate with area schools and mentors to ensure the ongoing success of our mentoring programs.
- Support campus Bible Clubs by encouraging the current club leaders and enlisting new leaders when needed.
- Maintain open communication and network with area Youth Pastors and Senior Pastors to build bridges between churches and youth groups and give encouragement when necessary.
- Engage our community through social media.
- Oversee the annual fundraising banquet and any other fundraising activities.
- Developing new ministries if/when the opportunity arises.

Qualifications and Experience
